01-06-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners namely, 1. Zabir Alam 2. Md. Kaif, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Kochadhaman P.S. case no.-126/2026, u/s 96 of BNS. Also heard learned P. P. for the State.

2. Prosecution story as per written report of informant is that on 04.03.2026 at about 11:30 PM she saw her minor daughter was missing from the house and she informed her husband thereafter they started searching their daughter. During search of her minor daughter on 05.03.2026 at about 09:00 AM he came to know that accused Md. Kaish alam trapped her daughter in love. When the informant went to Md. Kaish Alam's house where he found that Md. Kaish was also not at home and their family members said to the informant that they do not know about Md. Kaish. The informant has apprehension that her minor daughter has been kidnapped by the help of all the accused persons including these petitioners. On the basis of written report of the informant Kochadhaman P.S. Case NO. 126/2026 was registered.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have not committed any offence. Entire allegation alleged in the FIR are totally false, fabricated. They have been falsely implicated in this case. The victim girl left her house out of love affair. The petitioners have no role in this occurrence. Statement has been made in para 3 of the bail petition that the petitioners have clean antecedent

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

5. From perusal of record it transpires that there is allegation against these petitioners is that when the informant went to their house for searching the victim

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then they said that they have not knowledge regarding the victim and also abused them. There is allegation of kidnapping against co-accused Md. Kaish Alam who is not petitioner in this case. Considering the facts stated above, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner of bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petitioners namely, 1. Zabir Alam 2. Md. Kaif are hereby directed to be released on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from of receipt of the copy of this order in learned Trial Court, on furnishing bail bond of the amount of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned subject to the conditions laid down under Section 482 of the BNSS.
