02-05-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner namely, Jay Narayn Singh @ Babul Kumar Singh, Petitioner is in custody since 09.03.2026 in connection with Mahila P. S. Case No. 07/2026, registered u/s 70(1), 351(2), 351(3) of BNS. Also heard learned P. P. for the State.

2. Prosecution story as per written report of informant is that her husband resides in Jalandhar in connection of his livelihood and she resides in her house at village Kasettol, P.S.-Bahadurganj, Dist.-Kishanganj. At about 12:00 PM she was sleeping in her home. When she came out of house for natural call. In the mean time the petitioner along with other co-accused persons caught her in the courtyard and tied her mouth with Gamchha. Co-accused Fudan Singh shown knife to her and threatened that to keep silence and after that all the four accused persons committed rape with her and threatened that if she disclose this fact to anyone they will kill her. After that they committed rape with her three to four times due to which she became pregnant then she disclose this fact to her family members and her husband. Then her husband came at home and after that on 24.09.2025 she give an application in the Bahadurganj Police Station but no action was taken. On the basis written report of the informant Mahila P.S. Case No. 07/2026 was registered against the petitioner and other co-accused persons.

3. Apart from pleading innocence and false implication learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence. The informant herself admits in the FIR that

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she had allegedly submitted a written application before Bahadurganj Police Station on 24.09.2025, yet no copy of such application, station diary entry or any preliminary complaint has been brought on record. The FIR is completely silent about the exact date, month and year of the alleged occurrence. Despite the allegation of a serious offence like rape allegedly committed by several persons, the informant has not produced any earlier complaint, sanha entry or FIR before the police immediately after the alleged occurrence. The present case appears to be a result of personal dispute, social pressure or ulterior motive and the accused persons have been falsely implicated.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

5. From perusal of the record it transpires that there is allegation against the petitioner that he along with other co-accused persons committed gang rape with the victim/informant. From perusal of case diary it that the witnesses have supported the prosecution case in their statement before the police. Allegation against the petitioner is of gang rape which is serious in nature.

6. Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts and nature and gravity of allegations, I am not inclined to grant the privilege of bail to the petitioner. As such, prayer for bail made on behalf of petitioner namely, Jay Narayn Singh @ Babul Kumar Singh is hereby **rejected**.
