1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners namely, 1. Md. Ismail 2. Islamuddin who are in judicial custody since 15-03-2026 in connection with Thakurganj P. S. case No. 60 / 2026 registered u/s 189 (2), 126 (2), 115 (2), 118 (1), 109 (1), 74, 75, 352, 326 (f), 351 (2) of the BNS. Also heard learned P. P. for the state.

2. Prosecution case in short is that the informant Ruabza Begam submitted her written report alleging therein that on 26-02-2026 at about 7 p.m. the petitioners and eleven co-accused persons entered her boundary wall. They were armed with gun and were untying curtain. When the informant objected then she was abused and assaulted. Her clothes were pulled. When her husband and Mehraz came there then co-accused Sameer caused them injured by knife. The co-accused Masud assaulted Mehraz with iron rod upon his head. All the accused persons misbehaved with female family members of the informant.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. There is land dispute between the parties. All sections are bailable in nature except 118 (1), 109 (1), 74, 75 of the BNS. This case relates to the counter case bearing Thakurganj P. S case No. 59/ 2026 lodged by the co- accused Md. Israil. The petitioners are in judicial custody since 15-03-2026.

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4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

5. Perused the record and case diary. As per allegation, the petitioners and co-accused persons abused and assaulted the informant and her family members. They also misbehaved with the informant and other female family members of the informant. Witnesses in case diary have not supported the allegation of misbehavior with the informant. From injury report of the victims namely Md. Kayum and Mehraz Alam it appears that they sustained injuries simple in nature. There is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioners. From para 44 of the case diary it appears that the petitioners are also accused in one other case. The petitioners are in judicial custody since 15-03-2026.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and detention period of the petitioners, the petitioners namely, 1. Md. Ismail 2. Islamuddin are hereby directed to be released on bail furnishing bail bonds of the amount of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned.
