1. A fresh vakalatnama has been filed on behalf of the petitioners today. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners namely, 1. Arjun Kumar 2. Karan Kumar who are in judicial custody since 26-03-2026 in connection with Bahadurganj P. S. case No. 189 / 2026 registered u/s 126 (2), 115 (2), 132, 109 (1), 125 (A), 125 (B), 351 (2), 352, 3 (5) of the BNS. Also heard learned P. P. for the state.

2. Prosecution case in short is that the informant Police Officer submitted his written report alleging therein that on 25-03-2026 at about 12.15 p.m. he proceeded for his duty. When he reached Jhansi Rani Chowk a tempo hit his scooty and he fell down. The driver of the tempo and one occupant were laughing on him. When he asked as to why they were laughing, they started assaulting the informant. The driver of the tempo assaulted the informant with iron bracelet upon his head causing injury near right eye. The driver of the tempo collided with the tempo as the informant bent down and sustained injury. Both the accused persons

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assaulted the informant with fist and slap. The police personnel came there and rescued the informant. They were apprehended. Both the accused persons disclosed their name as of the petitioners.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. The allegations of brutal assault and life threatening blows using an iron bracelet are completely falsified by the medical evidence on record. The injury reports are simple in nature. The petitioners are in judicial custody since 26-03-2026. The petitioners have clean antecedents.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

5. Perused the record and case diary. As per allegation the petitioners assaulted the informant after the informant fell down due to collision by the tempo of the petitioners. The petitioner no. 1 also sustained injury in the occurrence. From injury report of the informant it appears that he sustained one injury i.e. abrasion near right eye and the same has been found to be simple in nature. In this case investigation has been completed and charge sheet has been submitted against the petitioners (vide para 66 of the case diary). The petitioners are in judicial custody since 26-03-2026. Statement has been made in para 3 of the bail petition that the petitioners have clean antecedents.

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6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and detention period of the the petitioners, the petitioners namely, 1. Arjun Kumar 2. Karan Kumar are hereby directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of the amount of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned.
