02-06-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner Salman, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Pathmari P.S. case No.-14/2026, registered u/s 87, 140(3), 3(5) of BNS. Also heard learned P. P. for the State.

2. Prosecution story as per written report of informant Noor Alam is that on 22.03.2026 at about 07:00 PM he was sitting in her Baramada which is family members and where talking to each other. In the mean time his minor daughter aged about 16 years gone for toilet behind his house but she did not return till long period then he and his family members started searching her. During search they got information that petitioner Salman and Co-accused Sajid took his daughter on motorcycle towards Bhawaniganj Madarsa. After sometime co-accused Sajid returned with motorcycle but Salman did not return. When the informant gone to the house of the petitioner for search of his daughter then co-accused persons abused and assaulted him. On the basis of written report of the informant Pathamari P.S. Case NO. 14/2026 was registered.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. Entire allegation made in the FIR are totally false, fabricated and concocted. The falsity of this case is evident from the perusal of the statement of victim U/s 161 Cr.P.C. before the police. She has clearly stated that no one has kidnapped her and she has left her house on her own will and she already has solemnized marriage with the petitioner as per muslim religion. The petitioner has never kidnapped nor abducted the victim. The

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alleged sections are not made out against the petitioner. As per para 03 of bail petition, petitioner has clean antecedent.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail and prayed to dispose the anticipatory bail petition.

5. From perusal of record it transpires that there is allegation against the petitioner that he kidnapped the minor daughter of the informant. From perusal of case diary it transpires that witnesses have supported the case as alleged in the FIR. From perusal of certificate of Bihar State Madarsa Education Board it transpires that date of birth of victim is 12.02.2022. It shows that at the time of occurrence she was minor. During investigation statement of victim was recorded U/s 183 BNSS in which she has said that she was in love affair with the petitioner and has gone with him on her own will. But from perusal of record it is clear that the victim is minor. Allegation against the petitioner is serious in nature. Considering the fact, I am not inclined to give privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and nature of allegation, this court does not find it to be a fit case for extending the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and as such the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner Salman is hereby **rejected**.
