1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners namely, 1. Nagma 2. Nashir 3. Shahbuddin 4. Md. Chand 5. Tafique 6. Kurban who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Kishanganj P. S. case No. 403 / 2026 registered u/s 115 (2), 126 (2), 117 (2), 74, 118 (1), 109 (1), 352 of the BNS. Also heard learned P. P. for the State.

2. Prosecution case in short is that the petitioners along with the co-accused persons assaulted the informant, her son and her husband with lathi danda, due to which the son of the informant sustained head and nose injury.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submitted that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. There is case and counter case between the parties. The offence u/s 109 (1) and 118 (1) is not attracted against the petitioners. There is compromise between the parties and for which they have filed compromise petition along with permission petition.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail but fairly submitted that there is compromise between the parties.

5. Perused the record and case diary. As per allegation, the petitioners along with the other co- accused persons assaulted the informant, her son and her husband for little land dispute. The injury sustained by the victim is simple in nature. Both the parties have compromised the case and the matter has amicably been settled. Both the parties have appeared before the court today who have fully supported the factum of compromise between them. The injury sustained by the victim is simple in nature. Statement has been made in para 3 of the bail petition that the petitioners have clean antecedents.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and nature of allegation against the petitioners, the petitioners namely, 1. Nagma 2. Nashir 3. Shahbuddin 4. Md. Chand 5. Tafique 6. Kurban are hereby directed to be released on bail in the event of their arrest or surrender within four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of the amount of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned.
