15-06-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner Md. Khalik @ Abdul Khalik, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Thakurganj P.S. case No.-51/2026, registered u/s 137(2), 139, 303(2), 3(5) of BNS. Also heard learned P. P. for the State.

2. Prosecution story as per written report of informant is that on 22.02.2026 at about 01:00 AM his minor daughter gone for toilet out of his house but she did not return till long period then he and his family members started searching her. During search they got information that petitioner Md. Kadir along with other Co-accused persons took his daughter along with golden and silver ornaments and Rs. 3,25,000/- cash on pretext of marriage. Accused kadir was working Makka field on monthly payment. He is further stated that the petitioner and his family members kidnapped her daughter. On the basis of written report of the informant Thakurganj P.S. Case NO. 51/2026 was registered.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence. The petitioner has been wrongfully dragged in this case. Entire allegation made in the FIR are totally false, fabricated and concocted. The victim went out of her house out of own sweet will. This petitioner has got no role to play in the aforesaid case. On suspicion petitioner has been made accused in this case. The petitioner craves leave to add, amend or alter any of the ground aforesaid. No overact has been attributed by this petitioner. The petitioner is ready to abide by any directions as this Ld. Court may impose. As per para 03 of bail petition, petitioner has clean antecedent.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail and prayed to disposes the anticipatory bail petition.

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5. From perusal of record it transpires that there is allegation against the this petitioner that he along with other co-accused person kidnapped the minor daughter of the informant. During investigation statement of victim was recorded U/s 183 BNSS in which she has stated that when she gone out of her house for natural call then the petitioner and co-accused Kadir took her near Makka field. After that co-accused Kadir took her to some unknown place. Allegation against this petitioner is that he was also involved in kidnapping of the victim. There is sufficient material available on the record against him. Investigation in this case is still pending. Allegation against the petitioner is serious in nature. Considering the fact, I am not inclined to give privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and nature of allegation, this court does not find it to be a fit case for extending the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and as such the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner Md. Khalik @ Abdul Khalik is hereby **rejected**.
