1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners namely, 1. Aayub 2. Serajul who are in judicial custody since 02-05-2026 in connection with Sukhani P. S. case No. 31 / 2026 registered u/s 331(4), 126(2), 109(1), 117(2), 352, 351(3), 303(2), 3(5) of the BNS. Also heard learned P. P. for the state.

2. Allegation against the petitioners is that the petitioners along with other co- accused persons assaulted the informant and his sister with knife and iron rod and took away the cash of Rs. 15000/- and 10 bhar silver ornaments from his house.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. Entire allegations are false and concocted levelled due to land dispute. There is case and counter case between the parties. The petitioners are in judicial custody since 02-05-2026. The petitioners have clean antecedents.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

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5. Perused the record and case diary. As per allegation, the petitioners along with other co- accused persons assaulted the informant and his sister with knife and iron rod and took away the cash of Rs. 15000/- and 10 bhar silver ornaments from his house. Both the parties are own relatives and the case diary transpires that for sharing of land, there occurred an altercation and scuffling between the parties. From injury report vide para 57 of the case diary, it appears that the C. T. Scan report of victim's brain shows no obvious abnormality. The petitioners are in judicial custody since 02-05-2026.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petitioners namely, 1. Aayub 2. Serajul are hereby directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of the amount of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned.
