1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner Md. Aslam who is in judicial custody since 25-04-2026 in connection with Bahadurganj P. S. case No. 274 / 2026 registered u/s 115 (2), 126 (2), 190, 191 (2), 74, 109 (1), 351 (2), 352 of the BNS. Also heard learned P. P. for the state.

2. Prosecution case in short is that the petitioner along with the co- accused persons assaulted the informant and his mother with weapons, due to which the mother of the informant and informant sustained head injury. They also outraged their modesty and snatched silver ornament.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. There is a land dispute between both the parties. The offence u/s 109 (1) of the BNS is not attracted against the petitioner. Both the parties have compromised the case for which separate compromise petition has also been filed in this case. The petitioner has clean antecedent and he is in judicial custody since 25-04-2026.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail but fairly submitted that there is compromise between the parties.

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5. Perused the record and case diary. As per allegation, the petitioner along with the co- accused persons assaulted the informant and her mother with weapons, due to which the mother of the informant and informant sustained head injury for little land dispute. From para 50 of the case diary, it appears that the victims sustained head injury is found to be simple in nature. Both the parties have compromised the case. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 25-04-2026. Statement has been made in para 3 of the bail petition that the petitioner has clean antecedent.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and detention period of the the petitioner, the petitioner Md. Aslam is hereby directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of the amount of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned.
