17-06-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner namely, Kadir, who is in custody since 26.03.2026 in connection with Bahadurganj P.S. Case No. 11/2023, registered u/s 379, 411, 412 of IPC. Also heard learned P. P. for the State.

2. Prosecution story as per written report of informant is that the theft of transmission line conductors from the under-construction 220KV D/C, Thakurganj Power Transmission Line project being executed by BSPTCL near Imadma Village unknown thieves cut and stole approximately 1892 meters of conductor wire between Tower No. 16A10 and 1710 during the night of 12.12.2022. Some damaged wire pieces were found at the site. On the basis of written report of informant Bahadurganj P.S. Case No. 11/2023 was registered.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. Allegations made in the FIR are false, frivolous and concocted. The co-accused persons namely, Ratan, Kaba, Rahim, Sam-sul have been granted bail on 23.03.2023 and Jitan and Yunus have been granted bail on 01.09.2023. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 26-03-2026. As per para 03 of bail petition, petitioner has also accused in five other case.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

5. From perusal of record it transpires that the petitioner was not named in the FIR. His name has been cropped up during investigation in the confessional

statement of co-accused Samsul, Abdul, Rahim and Rakib @ Lal in which they have stated that the petitioner was also involved in the occurrence. From perusal of record it also transpires that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has mentioned in para 03 of the bail petition that five cases are pending against him as criminal antecedent, but in all the cases he is on bail. Co-accused persons have been already granted bail by the Court of Ld. C.J.M., Kishanganj. The petitioner is in custody since 26.03-2026. Considering the facts and period of custody already undergone by the petitioner, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

6. Accordingly the petitioner namely, Kadir is hereby directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of the amount of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Learned Court Concerned.
