1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner Sanjida Khatoon who is apprehending her arrest in connection with Terhagachh P. S. case no. 171 / 2026 registered u/s 126 (2), 115 (2), 118 (1), 109 (1), 74, 303 (2), 352, 3 (5) of the BNS. Also heard learned P. P. for the State.

2. Allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner pressed the neck of informant and snatched her ornaments during course of assault along with the co-accused Julfed Alam. Due to which the informant sustained head injury.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is a lady. The offence as alleged in the FIR is not attracted against the petitioner rather it has been inserted to make the case serious. Both the parties have compromised the case for which they have filed compromise petition along with permission petition with this bail petition. Moreover co-accused Julfed Alam has been granted bail by this court earlier vide order dated 10-06-2026 passed in B. P. no. 212/ 2026.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

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5. Perused the record and case diary. As per allegation, the petitioner along with co- accused Julfed Alam assaulted the informant by pressing her neck, due to which she sustained head injury. There is compromise between the parties for which they have filed the compromise petition along with permission petition. The injury sustained by the informant found to be simple in nature (vide para 33 of the case diary). The petitioner is a lady having no criminal antecedent. Co-accused Julfed Alam has been granted bail by this court earlier vide order dated 10-06-2026 passed in B. P. no. 212/ 2026.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petitioner Sanjida Khatoon is hereby directed to be released on bail in the event of her arrest or surrender within four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of the amount of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned.
