SESSIONS JUDGE-II, KAIMUR AT BHABUA <u>Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 115 of 2026</u> Ganga Prajapti @ Ganga Kohar V/s State An anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely Ganga Prajapti @ Ganga Kohar who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Chand P.S Case No. 06 of 2026 registered for the offence U/s 126(2), 115(2), 74, 303(2), 352 of BNS. Copy of bail petition has duly been served to Id. A.P.P. Heard learned counsel Sri Bishnu Nand Singh on behalf of the petitioner and learned APP for the State as well as learned counsel Sri Jai Prakash Singh for the informant. Prosecution story in short is that, on 02.01.2026 at about 08:30PM while the informant was giving fodder to her buffaloes. At the same time, the informant's father-in-law approached there and started molestation to the informant, in the event he took the chain of the informant. Learned counsel for the accused petitioner submit that he is quite innocent and has committed no offence whatsoever. Earlier petitioner has not filed any bail application either in this court or any superior court. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent. All the alleged sections are bailable except 74 & 303(2) of BNS and are super added only with a view to make this case non-bailable. There is case and counter case between the parties. Charge-sheet has been submitted. On the basis of above facts Id. counsel for the accused petitioner submits that he is entitled for anticipatory bail. On the contrary Id. counsel for the prosecution has vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail. Heard both the sides. Perused the lower case record, it transpires that charge-sheet has been submitted in bailable sections except 74 & 303(2) of BNS. As per para 6 & 7 of the case-diary it reveals that no witnesses have uttered a single word regarding the offence U/s 74 of BNS. Nothing has been recovered and no value of stolen property has been given in the FIR. There is case and counter case between the parties. Considering these facts, petitioner is directed to be released on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to satisfaction of the court below within four weeks from the receipt of copy of this order. Further petitioner is directed to furnish undertaking in respect of well behaviour to the informant. (Dictated) Sd/- A.S.J II Kaimur	
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
