Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 111 of 2025
(Filing No. 437 of 2025)
Pappu Ram & Ors. Vrs. State.

This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners, namely, **1. Pappu Ram, 2. Haribansh Ram, 3. Vikki Ram @ Vikki Kumar and 4. Sugriv Ram** who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Ramgarh P S Case No. 09 of 2025 registered for the offences U/ss. 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 329(4), 79, 74, 303(2) and 3(5) BNS. Heard Sri Amar Kant Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners and learned PP for the State assisted by Sri Ashok Ram, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the informant.

2. Petitioners have mentioned in Para-2 of their bail petition that no bail petition anticipatory or regular on behalf of the petitioners has been filed or pending in this court or before the Hon'ble High court at Patna prior to this bail petition.

3. As alleged suddenly the petitioners reached the house of the informant and hurling abuses started beating him with Lathi-Danta and petitioner Haribansh Ram holding her hair pushed her down as a result she sustained injury and became naked and thereafter, they snatched away her Mangalsutra and when her son came to her rescue the accused persons beaten him with Lathi-Danta.

4. Denying any such occurrence as alleged has ever taken place it has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that both the parties are co-villagers and neighbors and this case is the outcome of differences cropped up between the parties on trivial issues, moreover, now the parties settling their differences have entered into compromise for which compromise petition has been filed.

5. Learned PP opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6. Heard both the parties and perused the case record. Petitioners are FIR

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named. Allegation against them, as per FIR, is that on dated 03.01.2025 at about 08:00 AM the informant of this case was cooking food. In the meantime the accused/petitioners came having Lathi-Danta in their hands and started abusing and beating her. The informant of this case is present in court and stated that a compromise has arrived between the parties with the intervention of well wishers of both the sides and she also filed the copy of compromise petition and further stated that she has no grievance left against the petitioners & she has no objection if, the bail petition of the petitioners is considered.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case the anticipatory bail petition of the petitioners is **allowed** and in the event of their arrest or surrender within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, the petitioners shall be released on bail on their furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below, subject to the conditions as laid down U/s. 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. or its corresponding Section 482 of B.N.S.S. (Dictated)
