Rakesh Singh Yadav @ Bacha Yadav vs. State of Bihar

16.04.2026	An anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of petitioner, namely, Rakesh Singh Yadav @ Bacha Yadav who is apprehending her arrest in connection with Chand PS Case No. 79/2026 registered for the offence punishable u/ss 132, 352, 351(2), 304(2) of the BNS. Heard Sri Kameshwar Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and learned APP for the State. The prosecution story in brief as made out from the written information that on 16.02.2026, a special camp was organized at Mauja Kheti for rectification of documents pertaining to pending compensation under the Bharat Mala Project. While the Informant was peacefully attending to the grievances of local raiyats, the petitioner-Rakesh Singh Yadav @ Baccha Yadav, arrived in the camp and started misbehaving. It is alleged that the petitioner abused the Informant in filthy language and directed him to forthwith vacate the camp premises. Despite efforts by the camp staff to pacify him, the petitioner made repeated attempts to physically assault the Informant, which were averted only upon intervention by the local villagers, who came to the rescue of the officer. Upon the Informant issuing a warning of police action, the petitioner displayed utter defiance and fearlessness. Before departing from the scene, he allegedly hurled life threats to the Informant and also attempted to snatch and destroy the official laptop. Consequent upon the written complaint lodged by the Informant, the instant FIR came to be registered against the petitioner.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has no role in the alleged occurrence. Actually he had gone to the camp for enquiry regarding the compensation of the acquisition of the land of his sister, namely, Surja Devi. When he was enquiry about the matter the informant became annoyed and lodged this false case against him. On these submissions, there is prayer of granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Learned APP vehemently opposes the prayer of the petitioner.

Heard. Perused the case diary. On persual it appears that there is allegation against the petitioner that there was camp organised for the compensation to the raiyats for Bharat Mala Project. The petitioner being care taker of the land of his sister approach the Circle Officer for enquiry compensation regarding the acquired land of his sister. As per case diary, there is only allegation of abusing and intimidation to the Circle Officer and other staffs. There is no injury in the occurrence to anybody. As per document of the petitioner, he was enquiry about the compensation with regard to land of his sister. The petitioner has clean criminal antecedents. Considering all the aspects of this case the petitioner's anticipatory bail is ***allowed*** and it is ordered that the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within four weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on ***furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties*** of like amount each to the satisfaction of court below.
