SESSIONS JUDGE-II, KAIMUR AT BHABUA <u>Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 395 of 2026</u> Chandrashekhar Singh @ Chandrasekhar Patel V/s State An anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely Chandrashekhar Singh @ Chandrasekhar Patel who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Bhabhua P.S Case No. 1084 of 2023 registered for the offence U/s 326, 307, 320, 166, 323, 325, 352 of IPC. Copy of bail petition has duly been served to Id. A.P.P. Heard learned counsel Sri Jitendra Kumar Singh on behalf of the petitioner and learned APP for the State. The brevity of offence is that, informant's son Abhikrit Sharma went to School on 10.07.2023 (Monday) at about 10:00AM and the headmaster of school (petitioner) beaten the informant's son due to which he sustained injuries on his eye and ear and loosing eye-sight. Learned counsel for the accused petitioner submit that he is quite innocent and has committed no offence whatsoever. Earlier petitioner has not filed any bail application either in this court or any superior court. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is false and fabricated one. Alleged sections are bailable except 326 and 307 of IPC. No case is made out against the petitioner. Petitioner is a government teacher and he has good reputation in the society. On the date of alleged occurrence school was closed, so there is no chance of any happenings. On the basis of above facts Id. counsel for the accused petitioner submits that he is entitled for anticipatory bail. On contrary Id. Counsel for the prosecution has vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail. Heard both the parties. Perused the case record as well as case diary. On perusal it transpires that on the alleged date of occurrence (i.e 10th July 2023) the school was closed due to First Shrawan Somwari. This fact has been supported with information No. 47 dated 07.07.2023 issued by the Principal of School as well as list of holidays of the year 2023 notified by office of District Education Officer, Kaimur. Further as per para 68, 73 & 74 of the case-diary it clearly indicates that the petitioner is a man of reputation and alleged victim Abhikrit Sharma was suffering some problem in his eyes from long before. It transpires that due to some ulterior motive or grievance the petitioner may have been made accused in this manner. So, considering these facts and circumstances of the case, petitioner is directed to be released on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to satisfaction of the court below within four weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
