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1. Heard Sri Shree Prakash Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/ petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that he had not filed any bail petition, either anticipatory or regular except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Denying involvement of the petitioner in the commission of alleged murder, it is submitted on his behalf that the petitioner is not named in FIR nor anyone has claimed to have seen the petitioner committing the alleged occurrence nor his complicity in the commission of alleged occurrence was surfaced during investigation nor any cogent material to connect the petitioner with the commission alleged occurrence has yet been collected by the police and the petitioner has been in jail custody for more than two months.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.
 5. Heard both the parties & perused the case record. FIR against unknown. The name of this petitioner was surfaced during investigation as mentioned in para 39 of case diary. Allegations against him are that on dated 21.01.2026 at around 09:00 PM, the brother of this petitioner was drinking alcohol with deceased Sonu Kumar, and thereafter, assaulted him with handle of farsa for misbehaving with the wife of his

brother and due to head injury, the deceased Sonu Kumar collapsed and died. Thereafter, this petitioner along with his brother thrown the dead body of the deceased in a drainage near Kundi Ghat. The body of deceased was recovered and post-mortem was conducted in which cause of death is due to cranio cerebral injuries caused by hard and blunt impact. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that the allegation of killing the deceased Sonu Kumar, is against the brother of this petitioner and the only allegation against him as per case diary is that he helped his brother in the disposal of dead body. It is further submitted that there is no accusation against him in the statement of witnesses mentioned in case diary that he was involved in the killing of deceased. Charge-sheet against him has already been filed. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 88 of case diary.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and that, charge-sheet against him has already been filed and he is in judicial custody for more than two months, this bail petition of this petitioner is **allowed** and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties with like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial court.
