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1. Heard Sri Munna Prasad, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Alleging false implication of the petitioner, it is submitted that the petitioner is in no way involved in the commission of alleged occurrence as petitioner is a labourer and he perform work at the direction of the informant and thus petitioner has not cheated the informant in any way, moreover, the petitioner is a lady and is innocent.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
 5. Heard both the parties and perused the record. It transpires from the perusal of record that petitioner is FIR named and allegations against her as per FIR are that the construction of dam was going on at village Chumuruka and this petitioner has wrongly uploaded the photo of labours and made payment of Rs. 5750/- in their account through NMMS. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 3 of case diary. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that she is herself a labour and done the work on the directions of informant who is a panchayat rozgar sevak of that village.

6. Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstances and that petitioner being the lady and the only allegation against her is that she wrongly uploaded the photographs of labour due to which wrong payment were made to them, this anticipatory bail petition is **allowed** and in the event of her arrest or surrender within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, this petitioner shall be released on bail on their furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of trial court, subject to conditions as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
