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1. Heard Sri Shree Prakash Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/ petitioners and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned PP for State.
 2. Petitioners have stated in para 2 of their bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Alleging false implication of the petitioners, it is submitted on their behalf that both the parties are co-villagers and this case is the outcome of land dispute between the parties for which both the parties entered into minor scuffle for which case and cross-cases bearing Kudra PS Case No. 93/2026 has been lodged by both sides against each other, moreover, all the sections invoked in this case are bailable except section 303(2),109(1) and 76 of the BNS but the injuries sustained by the injured are simple in nature caused by hard & blunt object and as such no case U/s 109 of the BNS is made out while the allegation of commission of theft and outraging of modesty is super-addition and thus it is prayed that the petitioners may be granted anticipatory bail.

4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners.
5. Heard both the parties and perused the record. It transpires from the perusal of record that petitioners are FIR named and allegation against them as per FIR that on dated 03.03.2026 at around 07:30 PM, these petitioners entered the house of informant and misbehaved with her and assaulted her and when her family members came to her rescue, they were also assaulted by the accused persons. The injury report of the injured are attached with case diary showing pain and swelling which are simple in nature except one injury over left elbow joint to Tappu Shankar Singh which is grievous. Petitioner has criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 32 of case diary. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that a quarrel was occurred between the parties on the date of occurrence related to an old property dispute in which both sides have received injuries and lodged cross-cases against each other. It is further submitted that from the nature of accusation read with injury report, no case U/s 109 BNS is made out against them and the allegation of misbehaving and disrobing the informant appears to be super-addition.
6. Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail petition is **allowed** and in the event of their arrest or surrender within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, these petitioners shall be released on bail on their furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of trial court, subject to conditions as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
