**ORDER**

Date :18.04.2026

**1.** The above named petitioners seek anticipatory bail in connection with above noted Bhabhua P.S. Case no. 200/2026, registered for offences punishable U/S- 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2) BNS & 3(1)(v), 3(2)(v) of SC/ST Act. Heard the Ld. Advocated for the petitioners and the Ld. Spl. P.P on behalf of the state. Order dated 18.03.026, 25.03.2026, 02.04.20226, 09.04.2026, 16.04.2026 & 17.04.2026 shall form part of hearing of this order passed today.

**2.** The learned advocate for the petitioners submitted that prior to this anticipatory bail petition, no other regular or anticipatory bail filed or moved before the Hon'ble High Court or before this court. That the petitioner no. 1 Nagendra Yadav and petitioner no. 3 have one criminal antecedent bearing Bhabhua P.S. Case No. 385/2024 u/s 147, 149, 148, 341, 323, 324, 307, 504 of IPC & Sections of SC/ST Act in which they are already on bail and petitioner no. 3 Ravi Yadav has filed Bhabhua P.S. Case No. 386/2024 u/s 147, 148, 149, 241, 323, 324, 307, 506 of IPC against the informant party. That the accused / petitioners have committed no offence and they are innocent persons. The petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case due to previous Bhabhua P.S. Case No. 386/2024. The injury suffered by the petitioners are simple in nature. That the petitioners never assaulted the informant and his fam-

ily member nor abused them remarking caste name. That the petitioners are men of means and they are ready to furnish proper bail bond to the satisfaction of the Court.

**3.** Per contra, the Ld. Spl. P.P. for the State opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail by submitted that there was previous enmity between the parties and a criminal case FIR no. 385/2024 u/s 147, 149, 148, 341, 323, 324, 307, 504 of IPC & Section SC/ST Act was registered against some members of the group who assaulted the injured, and the accused petitioners were named in this case and along with other FIR named accused persons assaulted the injured with sharp edged weapons in his face, nose and stomach.

**4.** Heard both sides and perused the record. The present case registered u/s 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2) BNS & 3(1)(v), 3(2)(v) of SC/ST Act against the petitioners. The injured Sonu Kumar appeared before the Court and submitted that he was referred from Bhabhua Sadar Hospital to BHU Trauma Center, Varanasi and he was admitted their from 27.02.2026 to 01.03.2026, and the injury report issued by the Dr. Manish Kumar Bhaskar, M.O.S.H. Bhabhua, attached in para 50 of the case diary shows that the injured Sonu Kumar has suffered six injuries on his body and injury no. 1, 2, 5, & 6 are opined by the doctor simple in nature but injury no. 3 & 4 are opined grievous in nature. The petitioner no. 1 & 3 have three criminal antecedents and petitioner no. 2 have one criminal antecedents. The caste of the informant / victim was known to accused/petitioners and earlier also case under SC/ST Act was registered, therefore, considering the above circumstances, it cannot be said that no offence under SC/ST Act is committed by the petitioners and hence, the prayer of anticipatory bail of petitioners is dismissed being not maintainable u/s 18 of SC/ST Act.

The observations made in this order are based on material available on record till date and submissions of the parties and shall be confined for the disposal of anticipatory bail application and should not treated as an opinion in the further investigation of the case.
