1. Heard Sri Jaya Prakash Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/ petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Alleging false implication of the petitioner, it is submitted on his behalf that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case due to differences cropped up on trivial domestic issue, however, the injuries sustained by the injured persons are simple in nature and as such no case under Section 109(1) of the BNS is made out and rest sections invoked in this case areailable. It is further submitted that petitioner is a lady and co-accused having similar allegation have been bail out by this court vide order passed in BP no. 60 of 2026
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
 5. Heard the arguments of both the parties and perused the case record. It transpires from the perusal of record that petitioner is FIR named and allegation against her as per FIR are that on dated 19.12.2025, she along with other FIR named accused have beaten the father-in-law of informant and injured him. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that a quarrel was occurred between the parties on the date of occurrence

and both sides have received injuries in the scuffle and cross case is lodged by them against each other. It is further submitted that as per FIR, the injury is on left leg of the injured which is non vital parts of the body, so section 109 BNS is not attracted against the petitioner. It is further submitted that allegation against her is general and omnibus, no specific overt act is mentioned against her. Petitioner is stated to have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 3 of her bail petition.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail petition is **allowed** and in the event of her arrest or surrender within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, this petitioner shall be released on bail on her furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of trial court, subject to conditions as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
