1. Heard Sri Atul Kumar Tiwari, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/ petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Alleging false implication of the petitioner, it is submitted on his behalf that the elder sister of the informant was already married with the uncle of the petitioner and thus it is submitted that the informant and her younger sister are on visiting term at the house of the petitioner and, therefore, the informant family proposed to marry the elder sister of the informant with the petitioner to which the family of the petitioner refused upon which in order to teach lesson to the petitioner this false case has been filed, moreover, the mother of the petitioner has already filed a complaint case against the informant and his family bearing complaint case No. 91 of 2006 and that is why the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
 5. Heard the arguments of both the parties and perused the case record. It transpires from the perusal of record that petitioner is FIR named and allegations against him as per FIR are that the sister of informant is a student of BA-Part II of Sanjay Singh

Mahavidhyala Bhabhua and this petitioner used to misbehave and eve tease her while going to attend college and on dated 26.01.2026 at around 03:00 PM, the sister of informant has disclosed him about the incident and when he reached the house of this petitioner to complain, all the FIR named including this petitioner started abusing him and thereafter, assaulted him with lathi, farsa etc. The injury report of informant is attached with case diary showing minor swelling over head which is simple in nature caused by hard and blunt object. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 14 of case diary. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that no such occurrence as alleged was occurred and a quarrel was occurred between the parties over some trivial domestic issue in which both sides have received minor injuries, and a complaint case was also filed by the mother of this petitioner before CJM Bhabhua. It is further submitted that allegations against this petitioner is general, no specific overt act is mentioned against him and accusation of misbehaving with the sister of informant and snatching valuables appears to be super addition.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail petition is **allowed** and in the event of his arrest or surrender within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, this petitioner shall be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of trial court, subject to conditions as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
