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1. Heard Sri Shashikant Pandey, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/ petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned PP for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that he is innocent, has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case with a view to harass and defame him in the society. It is further submitted that petitioner is implicated in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Budhan Bind. It is further submitted that petitioner was not present at the place of occurrence nor indulged in sale purchase of narcotic drugs and nothing incriminating has been recovered from the physical or conscious position of this petitioner.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of this petitioner stating that co-accused apprehended by the police on the date occurrence and from whom 105 gram heroin was recovered, has disclosed the name of this petitioner and further stated that he has purchased the heroin from this petitioner behind the high school.
 5. Heard the arguments of both the parties and perused the case record. It transpires from the perusal of record that petitioner is FIR named and allegations against him as per FIR are that on dated 19.09.2025 at around 03:40 PM, the police team of Ku-

dra PS got information that one Budhan Bind along with his son are returning to their house after purchasing heroin. Police team apprehended both Budhan Bind and his son Shobha Bind near Rampur mod and on search of their person, 105 gram heroin was recovered. On further inquiry they disclosed that they have purchased the recovered heroin from this petitioner behind the high school. Petitioner has criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 34 of case diary, one more case under NDPS Act is pending against him. It is submitted on behalf of prosecution that specific allegation against this petitioner of selling the recovered heroin to co-accused which was seized by the police and petitioner has criminal antecedent of similar nature.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case. I am not inclined to grant him the benefit of anticipatory bail. Hence, his bail petition is **dismissed**. (Dictated)
