1. Heard Sh. Amit Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned PP for State.
 2. The case of prosecution is that on dated 19.10.2025 at around 6:00 PM, informant of this case was returning to his house on motorcycle from Rajesh Medical, Mohania after winding up his work. When he reached near Khalsapur Bridge at around 6:30 PM, three persons on a motorcycle came covering their face and started beating the informant and injured him. The accused persons have also looted his motorcycle, android phone and cash around Rs. 5000/- and fled away.
 3. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that he has not filed any bail petition except this either before this court or Hon'ble High Court Patna.
 4. Denying any such occurrence as alleged was ever taken place, it has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he is innocent, has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. Learned counsel further submitted that the name of this petitioner was surfaced in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co- accused against whom charge-sheet has already been filed and nothing incriminating article related to this case was recovered either from the possession of this pe-

tioner or from his place. It is, therefore, prayed that this bail petition may be allowed.

5. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of this petitioner stating that he is involved in the snatching of motorcycle and other valuables under threat from the informant.
6. Heard the arguments of both the parties and perused the case record. It transpires from the perusal of case record that petitioner is not named in FIR. His name was surfaced in the confessional statement of co – accused attached with case dairy. Allegations against him are that he alongwith other co-accused have snatched the motorcycle, mobile phone and other valuables from informant and injured him. Charge-sheet against co-accused has already been filed. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that nothing incriminating article related to this case was recovered from the possession or place of this petitioner. It is further submitted that the only incriminating material against him is the confessional statement of co- accused which has no evidentiary value in the eye of law. Petitioner is stated to have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 3 of his bail petition.
7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the anticipatory bail petition of this petitioner is **allowed** and he is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court.
