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1. Heard Sri Raushan Kumar Yadav, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. The case of prosecution is that on dated 04.03.2026, one Bhim of village Dewarjika booked his DJ and he visited the place to play the DJ, Bhim asked him to bring three halogen lights and when informant along with his brother and father went with halogen light, the accused persons started colors throwing on them and when he objected, accused Udal Bind, Mithai Bind and son of Sidhai Bind along with unknown persons abused and beaten the informant and his brother with lathi and snatched their mobile phone. The accused persons have also damaged their motorcycles.
 4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he is innocent, has not committed any offence, has been falsely implicated in this case on the basis of concocted story. It is further submitted that no such occurrence as alleged was committed, rather, the informant called his family members on mobile and beaten the petitioner and other villagers. It is further submitted that no case U/s 109, 303(2) BNS is made out against him. It is, therefore, prayed that this bail petition may please be allowed.
 5. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Heard the arguments of both the parties and perused the case record. It transpires from the perusal of record that petitioner in FIR named and allegations against him are that he along with other named accused and some unknown persons have beaten and injured the informant and his family members and snatched mobile from him and damaged his motorcycles. The injury report of the injured are attached with case diary showing no injury to informant and injury to his brother and father are simple in nature caused by HBS. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 24 of case diary. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that an altercation was taken place between the parties during playing of DJ. It is further submitted that allegations against this petitioner are general and omnibus, no specific overt act is mentioned against his name and the injuries to injured are simple in nature and the accusation of snatching mobile appears to be super addition.
7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail petition is **allowed** and in the event of his arrest or surrender within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, this petitioner shall be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of trial court, subject to conditions as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
