1. Heard Sri Anil Kumar Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioners and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioners have stated in para 2 of their bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Denying any such occurrence as alleged was ever taken place, it is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they are innocent and have committed no offence and all the sections invoked in this case are bailable except Section 109(1) BNS which is not applicable in this case. It is further submitted that this case is the out come of the differences cropped up between the parties on trivial issues for which case and counter case bearing Bhabua P.S. Case No. 198 of 2026 have been lodged. However, with the interventions of well wishers of both the parties, they have compromised the case and filed compromise petition which is on record.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

5. Heard the arguments of both the parties and perused the case record. It transpires from the FIR that on 26.02.2026 at 07:30 PM, the petitioners along with FIR named accused entered the house of informant and assaulted him with fighter and iron road and injured him. The informant is present in court in person and has stated that he has compromised the case with the petitioners for which compromise petition has filed which is on record. He further stated that he has no grievance left against the petitioners & further stated that he has no objection if the bad petition is considered.
6. Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail petition is **allowed** and in the event of their arrest or surrender within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, these petitioners shall be released on bail on their furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of trial court, subject to conditions as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
