1. Heard Sri Ashok Kumar Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/ petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that he had not filed any bail petition, either anticipatory or regular except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Alleging false implication of the petitioner, it is submitted on his behalf that he has been falsely implicated in this case on the basis of an engineered story however, the seizure list is itself contradictory and nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner and the petitioner has been in custody for about 02 months.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.
 5. Heard both the parties & perused the case record. Petitioner is FIR named and in judicial custody since 17.02.2026. Allegation against him as per FIR are that on dated 30.01.2026 at around 02:30 PM, the informant of this case was doing some work at the chamber of his agriculture field. In the meantime, two unknown person came on a white colour Apache motorcycle and told the informant that they are searching for some land. During conversation, they further stated that they can double the five hundred rupee note and further disclosed that they are printing the currency note and

also shown the paper of currency note. Thereafter, on dated 05.02.2026 the informant handed over to them rupees six lakh fifty thousand and the accused persons handed over to him a packet containing rupees thirteen lakh and then left the place. When informant opened the packet, he found plain papers in the bundle and informant further alleged that he was cheated by the accused persons including this petitioner. It is submitted on behalf of prosecution that there are specific allegations against this petitioner of providing counterfeit currency notes and investigation against him is still pending. Allegations against him are serious.

6. Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to grant them bail. Hence, this bail petition is **dismissed**. (Dictated)
