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1. Heard Sri Vijay Narayan Singh, Ld. Counsel on behalf of the accused/petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that earlier he has filed anticipatory bail petition before this court vide ABP No. 151 of 2026 which was disposed off on dated 28.02.2026 and since then, no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he is innocent, has not committed any offence and has been falsely implicated in this case due to village politics. It is further submitted that both informant and this petitioner are neighbours and gotiya and old litigation is going on between them. It is further submitted that there is no recovery of pistol or katta from the possession of this petitioner. It is, therefore, prayed that the regular bail petition of this petitioner may be allowed.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for bail of this petitioner stating that there is specific allegation against him of firing upon the informant and one of the bullet has hit her neck and injured her.

5. Heard both the parties and perused the record. It transpires from the perusal of record that petitioner is FIR named and in judicial custody since 27.02.2026. Allegation against him as per FIR are that on dated 21.05.2025 at around 11:00 AM. the informant was sleeping at the first floor of her house, in the meantime, this petitioner entered her room and started abusing her and thereafter, pull out a firearm from his waist and fired upon the informant thrice, one of the bullet hit on the left side of neck of the informant and injured her. Charge-sheet against this petitioner has already been filed and the injury report of informant is attached with case diary showing lacerated wound one centimeter circular in shape of left side of neck and opinion is reserved for x-ray report. It further transpires from case diary that one fire shell was collected from the place of occurrence as mentioned in para 05 of case diary.
6. Since, there is specific allegation against this petitioner of firing upon the informant and injured her, I am not inclined to grant him bail, hence, his regular bail petition is **dismissed**.(Dictated)
