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1. Heard Sri Prahalad Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Denying any such occurrence as alleged was ever taken place, it is submitted that no incriminating article has been recovered from the person or possession of the petitioner and co-accused having similar allegation has been bailed out by this court vide BP No. 124/2026.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
 5. Heard the arguments of both sides and perused the record. It transpires from the perusal of record that petitioner is FIR named in judicial custody in 13.02.2026 and allegation against him as per FIR that on dated 13.02.2026 at around 10:30 AM the police team of Bhabua PS intercepted a bus near JP Chauk and on search of potato gunny bag, parts of 02 country made weapon were recovered and further inquiry from the driver and helper of the bus this petitioner was identified as the owner of gunny bag. Charge-sheet against this petitioner has already been filed. Petitioner has

criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 39 of case diary one more case of similar nature is pending against him. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that nothing incriminating was recovered from the possession of this petitioner rather from the bus which is a public transport and other passengers are seated in it.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and that charge-sheet against him has already been filed & is in judicial custody of more than two months, this bail petition of this petitioner is **allowed** and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties with like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial court.(Dictated)
