This bail petition is filed by petitioner namely, **Rajnish Kumar** who is in judicial custody since 19.03.2026 in connection with Kudra P.S Case No.-273 of 2025 registered u/s-109(1), 3(5) of B.N.S. and 27 Arms Act pending in the court of Id. A.C.J.M-II, Mohania Kaimur.

Case of prosecution is based on the statement of informant recorded at Trauma Centre, BHU, Varanasi stating therein that on 15.06.2025 at about 04:15hrs when the informant was going to attend duty at Supaul District and for the same she was going to Kudra railway station with her husband to catch Bhabhua Patna intercity on motorcycle. As she reached Bajrang Palace G.T.Road then two persons on bullet motorcycle came near. On sound of motorcycle when she turned back saw a person riding the bullet is Ajay Paswan who is deputed in Supaul District as constable, shot her on left back. In result, she lost her balance and fell down from the motorcycle and become unconscious. She could not recognize the next person riding on the bullet. Further stated that the informant had taken loan from Ajay Paswan. Out of which Rs.65,000/-is still remaining to back. On 14.06.2025 Ajay Paswan called the informant for money then the informant replied him that she will give him and she is taking loan for the same. Ajay Paswan got angry and told her that when she back to Supaul for duty. At this the informant replied that she will go to Supaul tomorrow. And out of that enmity, when informant was proceeded towards railway station for getting into Bhabhua Intercity, Ajay Paswan and other accomplices shot the informant from the backside and she fell down and got unconscious. For this, Ajay Paswan engaged professional criminals and allegedly this petitioner was also involved in the crime.

Learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence. Further, it has been submitted that the anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner has already been rejected by the court of District & Additional Sessions Judge-II, Kaimur at Bhabhua as well as by the Hon'ble High Court Patna. Petitioner has not filed any application for grant of regular bail either before Hon'ble High Court, Patna or before Id. District & Sessions Judge, Kaimur except this one. It is further submitted that one of the co-accused namely Amit Kumar @ Raja has been granted bail by this court on 21.01.2026. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 19.03.2026. Hence, petitioner may be admitted on bail.

Ld. APP on behalf of the state opposes the bail petition and submits that the petitioner does not deserve to be admitted on bail as the allegations are serious in nature.

Heard both the sides. Perused the case record as well as case-diary, it transpires that the name of petitioner came in confessional statements of Co-accused Amit Kumar and Abhishek Kumar in para 64 and 79 of case diary in this offence. The mobile No-7488412919 of petitioner was found near location of crime. The investigation is still going on.

Hence, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, as well as the gravity, nature and punishment of offence, Investigation still pending. I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence, the prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail stands **rejected**. However petitioner has liberty to renew his bail petition after filling of chargesheet.
