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1. Heard Sri Markandey Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Alleging false implication of the petitioner, it is submitted on his behalf that no such occurrence as alleged was ever taken place, moreover, the sections invoked in this case are all bailable except section 109 & 303(2) of BNS whereas the injuries sustained by the injured are simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance and thus, as submitted from the facts of the case, no case for the offence under section 109 BNS is made out and the allegation of commission of theft is super addition.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
 5. Heard the arguments of both the parties and perused the case record. It transpires from the perusal of record that petitioner is FIR named and allegation against him as per FIR are that on dated 17.03.2026 at around 08:30 PM, the informant was returning to his house on a truck from Chainpur and when they reached near Khargawa mod, some persons stopped the vehicle raising slogans and the driver of the vehicle fled away from scene the crime but informant was apprehended and this petitioner

along with other FIR accused have snatched Rs. 60,000/- from his pocket and started beating him. The injury report of informant is mentioned in para 88 of case diary showing injury is simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that informant was driving the aforesaid truck and illegally carrying some cows and oxen and when the truck reached near Khargawan mod, some persons caught the driver and save the animal for which cross case bearing no. Chainpur PS case no. 126 of 2026 was lodged against the informant. It is further submitted that allegation against this petitioner is general and omnibus, no specific overt act is mentioned against his name. It is further submitted that petitioner has medical shop near Khargawan Mod and due to this reason his name was given. It is further submitted that from the nature of accusation as well as injury report, no case under section 109 BNS is made out and allegation of snatching money appears to be super addition. Petitioner is stated to have one more case pending against him as mentioned in para 3 of his bail petition in which he is stated to be on bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail petition is **allowed** and in the event of his arrest or surrender within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, this petitioner shall be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of trial court, subject to conditions as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
