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1. Heard Sri Shivanand Pandey, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/ petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Alleging false implication of the petitioner, it is submitted on his behalf that both, the informant and the petitioner are nearest agnates and due to land dispute going on between the parties, a simple scuffle took place between them for which case and cross case bearing Mohania PS Case No. 226/2026 have been lodged, moreover, there is no specific allegations of overt act against the petitioner.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for granting bail to the petitioner.
 5. Heard the arguments of both the parties and perused the case record. It transpires from the perusal of record that petitioner is FIR named and is in judicial custody since 27.03.2026. Allegations against him as per FIR are that on dated 26.03.2026 at around 07:30 PM, all the FIR named accused including this petitioner were abusing and threatening the informant for throwing drainage water in front of the house of informant and when he asked them not to abuse, this petitioner along with co-ac-

cused have assaulted the informant with iron rod and injured him, the accused persons have also assaulted the family members of informant and injured them. The injury report of all the injured attached with case diary showing injuries to them are simple in nature except some of injuries which are reserved for opinion. It is submitted that a quarrel was occurred between the parties on the date of occurrence in which both sides have received injuries and petitioners have also lodged Mohania PS Case No. 226/2026 against the informant and others regarding the occurrence. It is further submitted that injured from both the sides are discharged from hospital after treatment. Petitioner is stated to have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 3 of his bail petition.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and that petitioner is in judicial custody for more than one month, his bail petition is **allowed** and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties with like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial court.
