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1. Heard Sri Ashok Kumar Rai, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Denying involvement of the petitioner, in the commission of the alleged occurrence, it is submitted on his behalf that from the facts of the case main ingredient i.e. the intention to kill is completely missing and as such no case U/s. 307 IPC is made out while neither any fire arm has been recovered from the possession of hte petitioner nor any fire arm injury has been found on the person of the injured an d as such offence U/s. 27 of the Arms Act becomes super addition, moreover, no specific allegation of overt act is alleged against the petitioner whereas co-accused having similar situated allegation have been granted anticipatory bail by the Hon'ble High Court vide order passed in Cr. Misc. Nos. 27690/2024 and 52057/2024 and another co-accused having similar situated allegations has been granted ancitipatory bail by this court vide ABP No. 2042/2025.

4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for granting bail to the petitioner.
5. Heard the arguments of both the parties and perused the case record. It transpires from the persual of record that petitioner is FIR named and in judicial custody since 19.12.2025. Allegation against him as per FIR are that on dated 08.07.2023 at around 11:30 AM, the informant along with his friend reached near Pipal tree at Hanuman Mandir of Shivpur village. This petitioner along with other FIR named accused and some unknown persons came on three motorcycle and a four wheeler and stopped his vehicle and, thereafter, started bearing him with hockey stick and iron rod and injured him. The injury report of the informant is mentioned in para 56 of case diary showing abrasion and swelling over different parts of body which are simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that allegation against him are general and omnibus, no specific overt act is mentioned against this petitioners. It is further submitted that co-accused having similar allegation have been granted anticipatory bail by Hon'ble High Court, Patna vide order dated 07.05.2024 and 23.08.2024 passed in Criminal Misc. No. 27690 of 2024 and 52057 of 2024 respectively. Petitioner is stated to have criminal antecedent as mentioned in bail para 3 of his bail petition and he is stated to be on bail in those cases.
6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances coupled with period of custody for more than 3 months, this bail petition is **allowed** and the petitioner is directed to be realeased on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thausand) with two sureties with like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial court.
