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1. Heard Sri Ajit Kumar Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioners and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioners have stated in para 2 of their bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Denying any such occurrence was ever taken place, it is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that due to admitted land dispute case and cross case bearing Mohania PS

Case No. 188/2026 have been lodged by both sides against each other, moreover, all the sections invoked in this case are bailable except section 109 and 303(2) BNS, whereas the injuries sustained by the injured persons are all simple in nature caused by hard and blunt object and thus, it is submitted that no case under section 109 BNS is made out and the allegations under section 303(2) BNS is super addition.

4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
5. Heard the arguments of both the parties and perused the case record. It transpires from the perusal of record that petitioners are FIR named and allegations against them as per FIR are that on dated 13.03.2026 at around 09:30 AM, the informant was measuring his 4 decimal land purchased from one Raj Gria Singh with the help of government, in the meantime, all the FIR named accused including these petitioners came to the house of informant having lathi danda iron rod etc in their hands and started abusing the informant and, thereafter, assaulted his son and injured him and when informant came to rescue of his son, he was also beaten by the accused persons. The injury report of the injured are mentioned in para 33-36 of case diary showing injuries are simple in nature caused by hard blunt object. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 39 of case diary. It is submitted on behalf of petitioners that a dispute was occurred between the parties regarding measurement of land for which cross case is lodged by them against each other and both sides have received injuries in the quarrel. It is further submitted that injured from both sides were discharged from hospital after treatment.
6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail petition is **allowed** and in the event of their arrest or surrender within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, these petitioners shall be released on bail on their furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of trial court, subject to conditions as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
