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1. Heard Sri Amresh Kumar Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/ petitioners and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioners have stated in para 2 of their bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Denying any such occurrence as alleged was ever taken place, it is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that both, the informant and the petitioners are close agnate and the civil suit is going on between the parties, has been decreed in favour the petitioners and being annoyed with it, this false case is filed.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for granting bail to the petitioners.
 5. Heard the arguments of both sides and perused the case record. It appears from the perusal of record that petitioners are FIR named they are in judicial custody since 02.04.2026. Allegations against them as per FIR are that on dated 30.09.2025 at around 04:00 AM in the morning, the mother of informant went outside the house for morning walk, in the meantime, these petitioners along with other FIR named ac-

cused came having lathi, danda, iron rod etc. in their hands and assaulted his mother and snatched jewelry articles. The injury report of the injured is attached with case diary showing multiple injuries to her and injury no. 2, fracture of rib cage is grievous in nature. Petitioner no. 1 has criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 28 of case diary and he is stated to be on bail in that case and petitioner no. 2 has no criminal antecedent. It is submitted on behalf of petitioners that allegation of assaulting the mother of informant is general in nature, no specific overt act is mentioned against anyone of them. It is further submitted that injured is discharged from hospital after treatment.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances coupled with period of custody under gone, this bail petition is **allowed** and the petitioners are directed to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties with like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial court.
