ORDER

The present is a successive bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely, **1. Ram Bhavan Thakur** who is in judicial custody since 07.06.2021 in connection with Durgawati P.S. Case No. 124 of 2021 registered for the offences U/ss. 8(c)/20(b)(ii)(B)/29 of NDPS Act. The ld. counsel on behalf petitioner submitted that no other bail petition is pending on behalf of the petitioner either in this court or in any superior court and that there is no criminal antecedent of the petitioner. Both the assertions have been affirmed by the ld. Spl. P.P.

2. The ld. counsel on behalf of the petitioner prayed for the grant of bail on the ground that the allegations levelled against the petitioner are false and fabricated and he has not committed any offence. It is submitted that the previous bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner was disposed of by the Hon'ble court with a direction to this court to grant bail on its own satisfaction and subject to the condition that the petitioner will cooperate in the disposal of the trial and appear before the court as when required, once the charge against the petitioner is framed. As the charge against the petitioner has already been framed, the petitioner deserves be enlarged on bail on the conditions that the court finds appropriate.

3. The learned Spl. P.P. submitted that as the petitioner is a resident of U.P., the bailors, should be close relatives of the petitioner.

4. Heard the counsels and perused the record. Considering the entire material available on record and the submissions advanced by the counsels, in the light of the observation made by the Hon'ble Court in Criminal Misc. No. 45530/2021, the court finds it proper to enlarge the petitioner on bail on his furnishing the bail bond of Rs. 10,000 (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of

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24.01.2022 this court. Both the sureties to be the close relative of the petitioner. The petitioner shall file an undertaking to the effect that he would never engaged in the similar act again and that he would cooperate in the disposal of the trail of the case and appear before the court as and when required. The office is directed to verify and accept the bail bond keeping in mind social distancing norms issued by the Hon'ble High Court and the Union & State Government.
