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1. Heard Sri Hanuman Ram, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Denying allegation levelled against the petitioner, it is submitted on his behalf that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case on some trivial issues. However, the allegation leveled against the petitioner is false and concocted. It is, therefore, prayed that this anticipatory bail petition may be allowed.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.
 5. Heard the arguments of both the parties and perused the case record. It transpires from the perusal of record that petitioner is FIR named and allegations against him as per FIR are that on dated 21.10.2025 at around 07:00 PM, the son of informant was going to his new house at around 07:00 pm, when he reached near the village chowk, Petitioner Sunil Paswan started quarreling with him and told him to marry his sister, in the meantime, other FIR named accused came having lathi, danda, etc and started beating the son of informant and when he tried to save his son, he was also beaten by the accused persons. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that the in-

juries sustained by the injured persons are only pain and swelling. It is further submitted that a quarrel was occurred between the parties, on the date of occurrence, for which case & cross case is lodged by the parties against each other and both sides have received minor injuries in the scuffle. It is further submitted that injured from both sides are discharged from hospital after treatment. Allegations against this petitioner is general in nature and no specific overt act is mentioned against him and having similar situation allegation, co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail by this court vide order passed in ABP No. 2226/25 and co-accused Raghubir Paswan has been granted bail vide order passed in BP No. 666/2025 .

6. Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail petition is **allowed** and in the event of his arrest or surrender within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, this petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of trial court, subject to conditions as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
