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1. Heard Sri Prahalad Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioners and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioners have stated in para 2 of their bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Denying any such occurrence was alleged ever taken place, it is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that in order to save his skin from Ramgarh PS Case No. 96/2026 lodged a day before the alleged occurrence, this case has been lodged. Moreover, all the sections invoked in this case areailable save and except 118(1) BNS.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
 5. Heard the arguments of both the parties and perused the case record. It transpires from the perusal of record that petitioners are FIR named and allegations against them as per FIR are that on dated 04.04.2026 at around 04:00 PM, the informant along with her husband has brought a harvester for the cutting of wheat crop, in the meantime, these petitioners came and asked the informant that their crop will be cut and an argument was broken out between the parties and thereafter, these petitioners

have assaulted the husband of informant with lathi and injured him. Petitioners are stated to have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 03 of their bail petition. It is submitted on behalf of petitioners that a quarrel was occurred between the parties on the date of occurrence regarding cutting of wheat crop in which both sides have received injuries and cross case is lodged by them against each other. It is further submitted that allegations against these petitioners are general in nature and all the injured from both sides are discharged from hospital after treatment.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail petition is **allowed** and in the event of their arrest or surrender within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, these petitioners shall be released on bail on their furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of trial court, subject to conditions as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
