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1. Heard Sri Pratap Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he is innocent, has not committed any offence and has been falsely implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. It is further submitted that petitioner was not named in FIR, he is implicated in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Ram Bachan Mallah. Charge-sheet against him has already been filed and there is no material against him in the entire case diary to implicate him in this case. It is further submitted that co-accused Ram Bachan Mallah has already been granted regular bail by Hon'ble High Court Patna, vide Crl. Misc. No. 18129 of 2026 dated 25.03.2026 and the case of this petitioner is on similar footing. It is, therefore, prayed that the regular bail of this petitioner may please be allowed.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for regular bail to the petitioner.

5. Heard both the parties and perused the record. It transpires from the perusal of record that petitioner is not named in FIR. The name of this petitioner was first surfaced in the confessional statement of co-accused mentioned in para 37 of case diary. He is in judicial custody since 23.01.2026. Allegations against him as per FIR are that on dated 20.11.2025 at around 11:00 AM, co-accused Ram Bachan Mallah took the father of informant along with him for catching fish at nearby river and father of informant has Rs. 17,000/- in his pocket at that time. He further alleged that the co-accused visited the house of informant in the evening but his father was not with him and when he inquired, he was told that his father is roaming around in Ward No. 14. On the very next day in the morning, co-accused Ram Bachan Mallah has given the informant fishing net and slippers of his father and when informant started searching for his father, the dead body of his father was recovered from a bush on the bank of river. Informant further alleged that co-accused along with some unknown persons have killed the father of informant and thrown his body in the river. Charge-sheet against this petitioner has already been filed. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that his name is surfaced during investigation in the confessional statement of co-accused. It is further submitted that no incriminating article related to this case was recovered either from his physical or conscious possession. It is further submitted that the co-accused against whom there is allegations in FIR has already been granted regular bail by Hon'ble High Court Patna, vide order dated 25.03.2026 in Crl. Misc. No. 18129 of 2026 and the case of this petitioner is on similar footing.
6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and that charge-sheet against this petitioner has already been filed and he is in judicial custody for more than 03 months, his bail petition is **allowed** and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties with like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial court.(Dictated)
