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1. Heard Ramesh Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioners and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioners have stated in para 2 of their bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Alleging false implication of the petitioners, it is submitted on their behalf that both the parties are members of same extended family and this case is the outcome of dispute regarding a partition of family property for which Title Suit bearing no. 763 of 2024 is pending between the parties and due to this reason both the parties entered into free fight in which both the parties have sustained injuries for which case and cross-case bearing Kudra PS Case No. 417/2025 has lodged, moreover, the injuries sustained by the injured are simple in nature caused by hard blunt object and as such no case for the offence U/s 91 of BNS is made out.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners.
 5. Heard both the parties and perused the record. It transpires from the perusal of record that petitioners are FIR named and allegation against them as per FIR that on dated 16.10.2026 at around 05:00 PM, the informant went to her private land near her house for plantation, in the meantime, these petitioners along with other FIR accused came and started abusing her and when her husband and other family members ob-

jected the accused persons started beating her husband and other family members and snatched gold chain from her person. The injury report of the informant is mentioned in para 20 of case diary showing pain and swelling which are simple in nature caused by HBS. It is submitted on behalf of petitioners that the husband of informant and these petitioners are gotiya and a Title Suit No. 763 of 2024 is pending between them in the court of Sub-Judge-I Mohania. It is further submitted that allegation against these petitioners are general and omnibus. Petitioners are stated to have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 03 their bail petition.

6. Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail petition is **allowed** and in the event of their arrest or surrender within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, these petitioners shall be released on bail on their furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of trial court, subject to conditions as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
