State Vs. Birendra Singh @ Pappu Singh & Ors.

**ORDER**

**18.06.2025**

1. A petition U/s 227 / 228 CrPC were filed on behalf of petitioners Birendra Singh @ Pappu Singh, Ranjit Singh @ Guddu, Abhishek Singh @ Golu & China Devi @ Asha Devi for dropping of charge against them U/s. 307 IPC.
2. The brief facts of the case are the informant of this case Usha Devi has alleged that on dated 26.04.2022 at around 8:30 AM the above named accused / petitioners came and started abusing her. Thereafter, accused Birendra Singh @ Pappu Singh beaten him with iron rod, Abhishek Kumar Singh beaten him with lathi and Ranjit Singh beaten him with bricks, stone etc. When she raised alarm accused Chinta Devi came having lathi in her hand and beaten Rakesh Kumar Singh and injured him. Chinta Devi have also snatched Mangalsutra. She further alleged that cause of occurrence is uprooting of vegetables from her agricultural land by the accused / petitioners and when she objected, the accused persons have beaten & injured her.
3. It is submitted on behalf of accused / petitioners that after completion of investigation, IO have filed charge-sheet against them U/s. 341, 323, 337, 338, 504 & 506/34 IPC. However, the learned trial court has taken cognizance against them U/s. 323, 341, 307, 337, 338, 504/34 IPC. It is further submitted that from perusal of case diary, it is clear that only informant, her husband and son were examined as witness and no

independent witness was examined by the IO. It is further submitted that doctor found injuries are simple in nature and IO submitted charge-sheet in compoundable sections. It is therefore prayed that the charges U/s. 307 IPC may please be dropped against the accused persons.

4. Learned PP however stated that there is sufficient material against them in the case diary to frame charges U/s. 307 IPC.
5. Heard the counsel for petitioner and PP for State and perused the case record. From perusal of FIR & case diary, it transpires from the statement of informant & other witnesses mentioned in para 2, 6, 7 of case diary that accused / petitioners have brutally beaten the informant and her family members with iron rod, lathi, danda etc. with intention to kill them. The injury report of injured Rakesh Kumar Singh & Usha Devi are mentioned in para 34 & 55 respectively, showing multiple injuries to them and injury no. (i) of informant Usha Devi is lacerated wound over mid parieto frontal area of head in 'Y' shape.
6. So, from the perusal of FIR, statement of witnesses & injury report attached with case diary there is sufficient material against the petitioners to frame charges against them u/s. 307 IPC. Hence, this petition for dropping of charge U/s 307 IPC dated 27.05.2025 is hereby **dismissed**.
7. Put-up on 23.07.2025 for framing charge must be present physically on the date fixed.
