SESSIONS JUDGE-II, KAIMUR AT BHABUA <u>Bail Petition No. 254 of 2026</u> Dheeraj Singh V/s State The instant bail petition filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely Dheeraj Singh who is in custody since 10.04.2025 in connection with Ramgarh P.S Case No. 215 of 2025 registered for the offence U/s 105, 3(5) of B.N.S. Copy of bail petition has duly been served to Id. A.P.P. Heard learned counsel Sri Anil Kumar Singh on behalf of the petitioner and learned APP for the State as well as learned counsel Sri Sachidanand Pandey for the informant. Case of prosecution in short, is that, 13 years ago informant's sister (since deceased) marriage was solemnized with the petitioner. The petitioner and his family usually tortured the informant's sister for dowry and made demand of rupees five lakh. For that informant's sister filed a case in Sub Divisional Court, Mohania. Further alleged that the petitioner and other accused persons killed his sister. Learned counsel for the accused petitioner submit that he is quite innocent and has committed no offence whatsoever. Earlier petitioner has preferred Cr. Misc No. 87977 of 2025 which was rejected vide order dated 29.01.2026 except this no bail application filed by the petitioner in this court or any superior court. Petitioner has criminal antecedent of Ramgarh P.S Case No. 32/2019 U/s 302 IPC in which he has been convicted. There is nothing specific against the petitioner. No overt act was done by the petitioner. Accused petitioner is in custody since 10.04.2026. Chargesheet has been submitted against the petitioner. On the basis of above facts Id. counsel for the accused petitioner submits that he may be granted bail. On contrary Id. APP has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail. Heard both the sides. Perused the lower case record. Petitioner is husband and carrying an allegation of killing his wife by making negligence in her treatment when she was ailing. Chargesheet has been submitted against the him U/s 105,3(5) of BNS. The Petitioner has criminal antecedent of Ramgarh P.S Case No. 32/2019 U/s 302 IPC in which he has been convicted by the Sessions Court, which shows the conduct of petitioner. Earlier petitioner's anticipatory bail has been rejected by this court vide ABP No.1859 of 2025 as well as from the Hon'ble High Court vide Cr. Misc No. 87977 of 2025. Under the aforesaid mitigating circumstances and gravity of offence, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.
