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1. Heard Sri Aditya Narayan Prasad learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. The case of prosecution is that on dated 08.01.2026 at around 01:30 AM, the informant has heard some noise at the roof of his garage and when he flashed torch light, he saw this petitioner was breaking the roof of garage and on seeing the light, he jumped from the roof but was apprehended with the help of neighbours and iron rod was recovered from his possession.
 4. The counsel of petitioner has submitted that he is innocent, has committed no offense and has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that no stolen article was recovered from the possession or place of this petitioner. It is further submitted that on the date of occurrence, this petitioner was irrigating his wheat crop and was apprehended on the basis of suspicion. It is, therefore, prayed that this bail petition may be allowed.
 5. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Heard both the parties and perused the record. Petitioner is FIR named and in judicial custody since 09.01.2026. Allegation against him are that he was apprehended by the informant while committing theft at garage. Charge-sheet against this petitioner has already been filed. Petitioner has criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 03 of his bail petition, three more cases against him are pending in which he is stated to be on bail. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that nothing incriminating related to commission of theft was recovered from the possession or place of this petitioner and he was apprehended on the basis of suspicion.
7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, and that charge-sheet against him has already been filed and he is in judicial custody for more than four and half months, the bail petition of this petitioner is **allowed** and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties with like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial court.(Dictated)
