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1. Heard Sri Prahlad Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Denying involvement of the petitioner in the commission of alleged murder of the husband of the informant, it is submitted on his behalf that the petitioner is not named in FIR nor anyone has claimed to have seen the petitioner committing the alleged occurrence rather the involvement of the petitioner has surfaced during investigation that too on the basis of false statement of the petitioner and co-accused Shashi Kant & no cogent material connecting the complicity of the petitioner in the commission of alleged occurrence has yet been collected by the police, during the investigation and the petitioner has been falsely implicated on mere suspicion and has been incarcerated in jail custody since 02.02.2026.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for bail petition to the petitioner.
 5. Heard the arguments of both the parties and perused the case record. It transpires from the perusal of record that FIR against unknown. The name of this petitioner

was surfaced during investigation as mentioned in para 39 of case diary. Allegations against him are that on dated 21.01.2026 at around 09:00 PM, this petitioner was drinking alcohol with deceased Sonu Kumar, and thereafter, assaulted him with handle of farsa for misbehaving with the wife of petitioner and due to head injury the deceased Sonu Kumar collapsed and died. Thereafter, this petitioner along with his brother thrown the dead body of the deceased in a drainage near Kundi Ghat. The body of deceased was recovered and post-mortem was conducted in which cause of death is due to cranio cerebral injuries caused by hard and blunt impact. The eye witness to the occurrence has also corroborated the accusation mentioned in para 53 and 78 of case diary. It is submitted on behalf of prosecution that there is specific allegation against this petitioner of killing the deceased Sonu Kumar, and throwing his dead body in a drainage. Allegations against him are grave.

6. Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to grant him bail. Hence, this bail petition is **dismissed**. (Dictated)
