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1. Heard Sri Shashi Bushan Jaiswal, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. Alleging false implication of the petitioner, it is submitted on his behalf that Petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, moreover, both the parties are relatives and this case is the outcome of differences cropped up between the parties on trivial issues, however, the parties sorted out their differences and compromised the case for which compromise petition is on record.
 4. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
 5. Heard both the parties and perused the record. The case of the informant as per FIR is that on 07.05.2026 at around 07:30 PM, the petitioner along with other FIR named accused entered the house of the informant & assaulted her and her father and injured them. It is submitted on behalf of petitioners that this case is outcome of differences between the parties on trivial issues, however, with the interventions of well

wishers of both the parties, they have compromise the case for which compromise petition has been filed and copy there of is on record. The informant is present in court and and stated that she has compromised the case and filed compromise petition. She further stated that the injured persons have been discharged from the hospital after their treatment.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances coupled with period of custody undergone, this bail petition of this petitioner is **allowed** and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties with like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial court.
