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1. Heard Sri Baldau Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioners and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioners have stated in para 2 of thier bail petition that no other bail petition, either anticipatory or regular has been filed/pending except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. The case of prosecution is that on dated 10.12.2025 at around 05:30 PM, accused/petitioner Ajay Singh started abusing the husband of informant for an old dispute and then assaulted him with *tangi* and injured him and when informant went to rescue of her husband, she was also assaulted by accused persons including these petitioners.
 4. The counsel of petitioners have submitted that they are innocent, have not committed any offense and have been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted

that informant and petitioners are members of same extended family and a land dispute is going on between them and due to this reason, this quarrel was occurred in which both the petitioners have also received injuries & complaint case no. 879/2025 was instituted by the Petitioner No. 02 against the informant and his family members. It is thereafter, prayed that this bail petition may be allowed.

5. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioners.
6. Heard both the parties and perused the record. It transpires from the perusal of record that petitioners are FIR named and in judicial custody since 06.05.2026. Allegation against them are that they alongwith other FIR named accused have assaulted the informant and her husband and injured them. The injury report of both the informant and her husband are attached with case diary showing fracture over head which is grievous in nature caused by hard blunt object. It is submitted on behalf of petitioners that a quarrel was occurred between the parties on the date of occurrence related to an old property dispute in which these petitioners have also received injuries and complaint case is also lodged by the petitioners against the informant and others. Petitioners are stated to have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 03 their bail petition.
7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances coupled with period of custody undergone, this bail petition of this petitioners are **allowed** and the petitioners are directed to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties with like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial court.
