This anticipatory bail petition is filed by petitioners namely, **1. Sahil Kumar @ Gulabchand Kumar, 2. Vicky Kumar and 3. Sunita Devi** who apprehends their arrest in connection with Sonhan P.S Case No.-105 of 2026 registered u/s-126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 74, 352, 3(5) of BNS pending in the court of Id. C.J.M. Kaimur at Bhabhua.

Learned counsel on behalf of the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence. They have not filed any application for grant of anticipatory or regular bail petition either before Hon'ble High Court, Patna or before the court of Id. Principal District & Sessions Judge, Kaimur. There are no criminal antecedent against these petitioners. All the allegations against the petitioners are false and fabricated. All sections are bailable except 74 of BNS. FIR is delayed. Learned counsel has prayed to release the accused petitioners on bail.

Ld. APP on behalf of the state opposes the bail petition and submits that the petitioners do not deserve to be admitted on bail.

Heard both sides. Perused the record. As per the prosecution case, in brief, that on 06.05.2026 about 8:00 a.m. in morning informant went to house of Bikram Ram to call her husband from the mobile of Bikam Ram, then all accused persons come there with lathi-landa and iron rod in their hands and stated abusing and attacked the informant danda due to which informant got head injury.

Heard both the parties. The informant has instituted FIR u/s- 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 74, 352, 3(5) of BNS against petitioners in which except section 74 of BNS all are

bailable and section 74 of BNS prescribed maximum punishment up to five years. It Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Hence, keeping in view the above facts, it is directed that in case of arrest or surrender of the accused petitioners namely, **1. Sahil Kumar @ Gulabchand Kumar, 2. Vicky Kumar and 3. Sunita Devi** within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order be released on bail on furnishing the bail bonds of **Rs. 10,000/-** each along with two sureties of the like amount subject to satisfaction of the court of Id. Trial Court, Kaimur at Bhabua. The petitioners will submit an undertaking U/s 483(2) B.N.S.S at the time of furnishing the bail bond.
