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1. Heard Sri Prabhakar Kumar Dubey, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioner and Sh. Sachidanand Rai, learned P.P. for State.
 2. Petitioner has stated in para 2 of his bail petition that he has not filed any bail petition, either anticipatory or regular except this, either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna.
 3. The case of prosecution is that on dated 31.03.2026 at around 04:00 PM, the office staff of Hata Nagar Panchayat has communicated to the informant that two persons entered the hall of Nagar Panchayat and one of them pulled out a pistol and threatened the staff and fired, the bullet hit the wall above AC. This petitioner was identified as the person who fired upon the staff Nagar Panchayat through CCTV footage.
 4. The counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he is innocent, has committed no offense and has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that no such incident as alleged was occurred, rather on 31.03.2026 a tender was about to open in the hall of Nagar Panchayat and 20-25 persons were present there, in the meantime, an altercation was broken out between aspirants and someone has fired in the air and the name of this petitioner was given by the villagers having political en-

mity. It is further submitted no one was injured in the firing. It is, therefore, prayed that this bail petition may be allowed.

5. Learned PP has opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.
6. Heard both sides and perused the case record. Petitioner is FIR named and in judicial custody since 20.05.2026. Allegation against him are that he has threatened the staff of Hata Nagar Panchayat and thereafter, fired in the hall. An empty cartridge was recovered from the hall as mentioned in para 03 of case diary. Petitioner has criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 52 of case diary in which he is stated to be on bail. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that an altercation was broken out in the hall of Nagar Panchayat Hata at the time of opening of tender in which someone has fired in the air. It is further submitted that no one was injured in the firing.
7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and that petitioner is in judicial custody for more than one month, the bail petition of this petitioner is **allowed** and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties with like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial court.
