

IN THE COURT OF ADJ-1 CUM SPECIAL JUDGE KAIMUR AT BHABHUA

State **V/s** Arman Rain & Others

A surrender cum bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused namely, **1. Ismaeel Raeen, 2. Arman Raeen** in connection with Bhabhua P.S. Case No. 226 of 2021. Heard Sri Ramanand Singh, learned counsel on behalf of the petitioners and learned SPP for the state. The Ld. S.P.P. certifies that a prior notice of surrender by the petitioners has already been served to S.P.P. who certified that notice to the informant-victim. It is submitted that no other regular or anticipatory bail petition on behalf of the petitioners is pending either in this court or any superior court and the petitioners have no criminal antecedents. These assertions have not been objected to by the Ld. Spl. P.P.

The above mentioned accused are present in person before the court. It is submitted on their behalf that they have not committed any offences, are quite innocent & have been falsely implicated in the case. That no case u/s 3(1)(r)(s) of SC/ST Act is made out against the petitioners and other sections alleged are bailable in nature. That the co-accused in the case has already been enlarged on bail by this court and the petitioners are on similar footing. That the petitioners further undertake to cooperate in the investigation and trial of the case.

The learned Spl. P. P. opposed the bail petition.

Heard the counsels and perused the record. Also heard the petitioners present in person before the court. Considering the submissions advanced by the respective learned counsels in the totality of facts and circumstances & the fact, I find it proper to allow the present petition. The petitioners are directed to be released on their furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of this court. The office is directed to accept the bail bonds complying with the social distancing norms issued by the Government and Hon'ble High Court. The petitioners shall file an undertaking to the effect that they shall cooperate in the investigation and trial of the case and shall remain present on each and every date of hearing. (Dictated)
