	01.08.2026	This complaint case is filed on protest petition after Final Form has been submitted by the Investigating officer in connection with Mohania PS Case No- 290/2016. The present case filed under Section 302/34 Indian Penal Code 1860 by the complainant Nandu Singh Yadav s/o Ramkeyar Singh against five (5) accused persons named in the complaint petition. The fact in the nutshell is that, on 09.06.2016, the complainant came to know that the accused persons through conspiracy have killed his mother and throw her under the bridge. After knowing this fact, the complainant took her to Mohania Hospital, from where she has been referred to Varanasi. His mother died enroute to Varanasi. The complainant alleged that, he and accused persons having land dispute due to which they have allegedly killed his mother. The protest Complaint petition was accepted on 17.10.2021 and fixed for hearing on 17.11.2021. However, even after repeated reminders and opportunity, complainant did not turn up for the solemn affirmation. On perusal of record, it transpires that, it has been more than four years since filing of this protest complaint petition but till today complainant neither turn up before the court nor

made pairvi on his behalf.

Considering all these facts, an opportunity for S.A and production of inquiry witness has been closed by this court today. Through the conduct of the complainant, it appears that complainant no longer wishes to further proceed with the case and is not interested to pursue the case.

On perusal of the record, it transpires that, there is no material on record. As Complainant himself did not examine on oath also, no any inquiry witness has been examined to testify the veracity of the case. Therefore, it does not appear judicious to keep the matter pending any longer.

Hence, the complaint is hereby dismissed under Section 203 of Code of Criminal Procedure.
