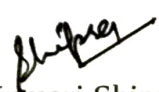

From perusal of record, it transpires that, a prima facie case made out under Section 323 & 341 of IPC and the order for issuance of summons against the accused person namely 1. Lal Saheb was made on 04.09.2025. Thereafter, the case record was put for filing requisites by the complainant within three weeks. However, the complainant failed to comply with the direction despite being afforded multiple opportunities. The complainant neither remain physically present before the court nor made any pairvi on his behalf. This clearly shows that; there is lack of interest on the part of complainant to continue this case any further. The section 204(4) CrPC describe the power of a Magistrate to dismiss the complaint if the process fee or other fees that are required to be paid by the complainant and are not paid within a reasonable time. In the instant case, the complainant has been given sufficient opportunities to file the requisites/ process fee but to no avail. In view of the above facts and circumstances, the instant complaint case is hereby dismissed in exercise of the powers granted u/s 204(4) CrPC.
